- B. Nadab and Abihu. Lev.10:1,2
- C. Naaman and the river Jordan. 2 Kgs.5
- D. Sprinkling and pouring for immersion. Rom.6:3,4; Col.2:12; Mk.16:16
- E. Vain religions of man. Gal.1:6-9
